Teign Corinthian Yacht Club, one of the oldest in the country, is looking to build a new Water Sports Hub on the River Teign in South Devon. There is a potential Sponsorship Opportunity for interested parties.



The new Water Sports Hub will be located on the existing TCYC grounds at Coombe Cellars Dinghy Park and will replace the present 1940's built wooden clubhouse with a brand new two-storey building.

What's Happening?

TCYC is fund raising in order to build a new clubhouse for all water-sports users on the River Teign. This is for users like dinghy sailors, kayakers, wind-surfers, paddle boards, rowers and the like.

Why?

TCYC has a membership of well over 400. A new clubhouse is desperately needed to cope with the bulging number of family members and youngsters at TCYC's thriving dinghy section.

Plans

Downstairs will have up to date changing facilities for 50 (males, females, children and babies) plus toilets, a classroom all with access for the less abled. Presently we cater for 24 at a squeeze and have no baby changing or disabled toilet facilities.

Upstairs will be an open plan lounge with commanding views of the river and be a warm and safe place for young and old alike.

Funding

We need to raise funds in excess of £150k in order to build our new 2-storey club. Additionally £60k of in-kind work will be undertaken free of charge by skilled club members to build and fit out the clubhouse.

Progress

Planning Permission was granted by Teignbridge District Council in December 2017.

Funding Applications made late April to:

- ❖ Sport England for £75,000
- ❖ Viridor Credits for £20,000

More than £3,500 has been raised through club activities up to and including September 2018.

HOW TO BECOME A PATRON OF TEIGN CORINTHIAN YACHT CLUB

Background

During the Victorian era yachting had developed at Teignmouth to the point where Teignmouth Corinthian Sailing Club was formed in 1886. The club's first clubhouse was built in 1891 at the end of the Pier. This continued in use until 1946 when co-incidentally, and with the influx of members with 'motor cruisers', the club changed its name to Teign Corinthian Yacht Club.

Eastcliff Clubhouse

The club then occupied various premises in Teignmouth until 1995 when the club's purpose-built clubhouse was opened. The TCYC clubhouse is at the Eastcliff end of Teignmouth seafront, giving panoramic views of the coast - a great place to watch the yacht racing, especially in bad weather!

The clubhouse is fully equipped with bar, kitchen, offices, toilets, sound and lighting, and is an excellent venue for a party. The regular club night is Friday.

Coombe Cellars - and why we are looking for Patron

The Coombe Cellars site was purchased in 1964 and is TCYC's dinghy sailing facility. It is located on the south side of the Teign estuary, next to the Coombe Cellars public house.

There is a clubhouse, dinghy park, slipway and storage. The mild weather allows racing throughout the year, on Saturdays and Sundays, around two hours either side of high tide. The estuary provides several square miles of uncrowded water, and the coastal location provides the extra challenges of tidal flow and rapidly changing weather!

The Coombe Cellars clubhouse is now bursting at the seams so successful has it been in attracting family members with youngsters. There is sail training going on almost every week during the summer months when the tides are right - around 10 to 20 at a time being trained. A new two-storey clubhouse has been given planning permission and we are seeking funds to build this. This will be a new water-sports hub for all manual or wind powered craft, not motorised craft.
